



Documents of Mission La Purisima Concepcion mention the Jalama Rancheria near Point Conception, as early as 1781. The name “Jalama” originates from the Purisemeno Chumash village name, “Xalam,” (meaning “bundle.”)

Cuvée Jalama was produced by blending cool climate Syrah from Santa Barbara County (Cargasacchi-Jalama vineyard) with warm-climate Syrah from Paso Robles (French Camp). The Cargasacchi-Jalama Syrah component was co-fermented with 10% whole-cluster Viognier from Larner Vineyard in Ballard Canyon. Viognier comprises 5% of the final blend.

An aromatic wine with flavors of black cherry, currants and plums. Long finish with suggestion of blackberry, crème brûlée and cocoa.
