Their weapons are all made of gold and everywhere abounds with gold and precious stones...” The origins of the name California, in common with El Dorado, Quivira, the Seven Cities of Cibola and other fantastic places sought by the Conquistadors is rooted in mythology and romance. In 1510 Spain the story of this magical place was published in “The Deeds of Esplandian.”

Think pink Viognier. This aromatic "fruit cocktail in a glass" has maximum yummy factor. Perfect for picnics, sipping as an aperitif or with antipasto. Aromatics of apricot, strawberry, pineapple and ripe fruit explode from the glass. A bright crisp mouth-feel and balanced minerality make this dry rosé a delicious and elegant aperitif.

Promiscuous! A dry rosé fermented in neutral oak barrels with no malo-lactic fermentation. The Syrah component consists of saignée from de-stemmed but not crushed Syrah berries after 3 days of cold soaking. Both the Syrah and Viognier were fermented with a Burgundian yeast normally used for Chardonnay.
